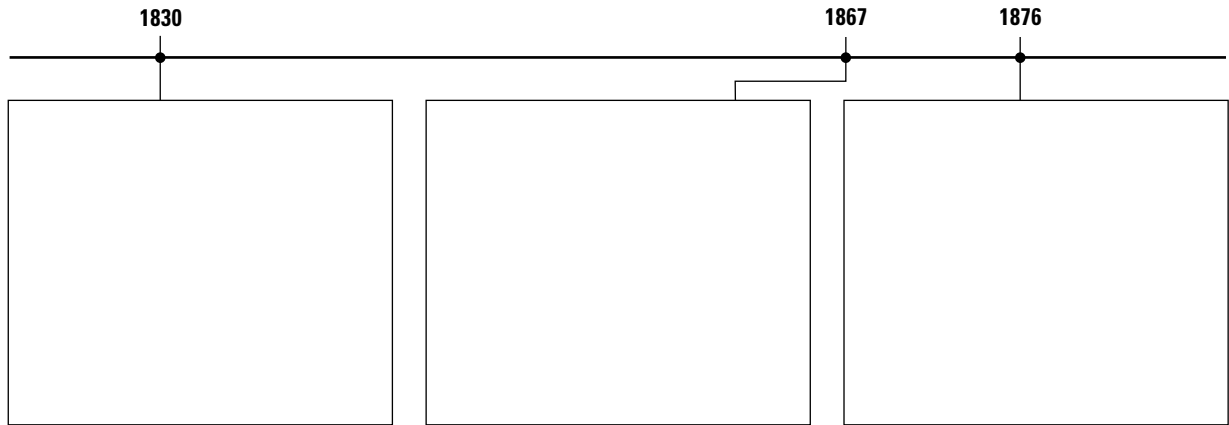


Challenges Faced by Settlers	How Settlers Changed the West	Effect on American Indians
